

By registering for the Who Will Go Camp, you affirm that you agree to willingly abide by these rules, be a good sportsman, dress according to camp policy, and exhibit a good Christian disposition at all times. You also agree to follow the directives of the camp director and leadership at all times. You understand that failure to comply with camp rules may result in dismissal from camp, requiring your parent/guardian to make arrangements for your early departure.

Bro. Chris Hewett and the camp staff reserve the right to set and maintain the highest biblical standards in keeping with consistent Christian conduct. Please review this summary of our standards. Note that this list is intended to be general, and the directors have final authority to apply and interpret these standards.

## **DOCTRINE:**

Who Will Go Missions Camp is proudly an Independent Baptist Camp and will be governed accordingly in faith and doctrine. We use only the King James Bible. Our music and manner of worship may be considered 'old-fashioned,' but we believe they are in keeping with the word and spirit of the Scriptures.

#### **DISCIPLINE:**

All camp activities are designed to be a fun experience for all participants while also allowing time to draw closer to the Lord and hear His voice without unnecessary distractions. Please observe the following general rules of conduct:

- NO cigarettes, snuff, or other tobacco products (youth and adults).
- **NO** drugs, firearms, fireworks, radios, alcoholic beverages, rock music, country music, CD players, tape players, record players, TVs, video games (or gaming devices), computers, or Palm devices.
- **NO** knives, guns, or other weapons.
- **NO** magazines or books (Exception: a personal devotional book such as *Baptist Bread* or a similar daily devotional is acceptable).
- Cell phones are permitted but must be surrendered to your counselor, who will control phone usage.
- There is **no cell service** at the camp, so be prepared to have **no communication** with those outside of camp.
- The camp phone is off-limits to campers. In an emergency, a counselor will contact the parents.

#### **DRESS CODE:**

# PLEASE REVIEW CAREFULLY! Our dress code is designed to:

- 1. Promote modesty
- 2. Avoid attracting inappropriate attention
- 3. Maintain a Christ-honoring appearance
- 4. Avoid worldly fads

#### **LADIES:**

- **NOT permitted:** Pants, shorts, gauchos, miniskirts/dresses that reveal the thigh, slits above the knee, sleeveless or low-cut dresses/tops, midriff-revealing tops, bare-back clothing, or see-through/tight clothing.
- Dresses/skirts/jumpers must be at least mid-calf length for services.
- Skirt-appearing culottes (at least mid-calf length) are permitted for daily activities.
- If not wearing culottes, **full skirts** that reach mid-calf are recommended for all activities (leggings or long shorts underneath for modesty and protection).
- Exercise skirts that reach mid-calf or skirts that reach the base of the knee with mid-calf leggings may be worn.
- Sneakers must be worn for daily activities.
- Bring dark blue or black **T-shirts** for designated water activities to ensure Christian modesty.

Mirror Test: Raise your hands, touch your toes—if anything shows, go change your clothes!

#### **GENTLEMEN:**

- **NOT permitted:** Shorts, sweatpants (wind pants are acceptable), tank tops, sleeveless shirts, muscle shirts, cutoffs, or skinny jeans.
- Shirts must be worn at all times.
- **Jeans or wind pants** should be worn for daily activities with comfortable T-shirts and sneakers.
- For services: Jeans/slacks with a collared shirt (T-shirts are discouraged, but not prohibited). Button-up shirts and ties are not required but are always appropriate.
- **Caps/hats** should not have inappropriate words, advertising (e.g., country/rock music, alcohol, tobacco), or inappropriate pictures. Ideal T-shirts promote your home church or school.
- No caps in the dining hall or tabernacle.

#### **ATTIRE FOR WATER TRAINING:**

• Males and females will train together. **FULL CLOTHING**, as listed above, will be required.

- Ladies: A one-piece bathing suit may be worn underneath clothing. Wear a dark T-shirt and below-the-kneedark culottes, an exercise skort, or a pinned dark full skirt.
- Gentlemen: A dark T-shirt and wind pants must be worn.
- **Denim is strongly discouraged** for water activities as it becomes very heavy and can hinder movement.
- Christian modesty will be observed, monitored, and enforced during training.

#### **CAMPACCOMMODATIONS:**

- Room and bed assignments are at the discretion of camp staff.
- Campers are NOT permitted to change rooms/beds without staff permission.
- Chaperones are NOT allowed to make room changes for their groups without approval.
- **Bed counts are conducted nightly** for the safety of campers and staff. **Full participation is required.**

# FAILURE TO FOLLOW STAFF DIRECTIVES REGARDING ROOM ASSIGNMENTS MAY RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL FROM CAMP.

- Curfew & Lights Out:
  - o At designated **lights-out time**, campers must be in their respective rooms, quiet, with lights off.
  - o If found outside the room after **lights out**, the camper may be dismissed from camp.
  - o Rules will be explained during orientation.
  - o Campers are NOT permitted to leave the property or assigned areas.

## **GENERAL CONDUCT EXPECTATIONS:**

- **Good sportsmanship** is expected at all times. Campers should participate both in the **letter** and **spirit** of activities.
- Camp will be what you make of it!
- All campers must attend all services and activities.
- Adults are expected to attend all services as well.
- Campers who **refuse to participate** or **fail to follow camp rules**, including the dress code, may be dismissed from camp. **Parents/guardians will be contacted to pick up the dismissed camper.**

By attending Who Will Go Missions Camp, you are agreeing to abide by these standards and guidelines. We encourage you to come with a willing heart, a Christ-like attitude, and a desire to grow in your faith as we seek to train the next generation for missions.
